Chikkanna Governemnt Arts College, Tirupur - 641 602 Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) 2022-23

The Student satisfaction survey was conducted for the outgoing students both UG and PG of various departments of the college. A questionaire with 30 questions was prepared and was given to the students. Each question was weighted on a scale starting from 0 to 5. One question Q. No. 23 regarding NET/SET Coaching clases was not applicabe to the UG students. So the UG students was given a weightage of 145 points and the PG Students a weightage of 150 points. Each student paricipating in the survey was given a scoring sheet where the students ID was not requested. The points were calculated by adding the score of each student multiplied by the number of students participating in the survey respectively. This score divided by the total maximu points x 100 gave the % satisfaction survey of each course. For the college the total of all points divided by maxium points possible (No of students participating in the survey multiplied by maxium points) gave the overal performance of he College. Points 0-1 given by the students for different parameters were closely analysed and corrective measures were taken up for the subsquent Academic Years.
